FALL APPLE CIDER

Ingredients:

4 cups pure apple juice
2 cinnamon sticks, 4 inches
8 whole cloves
8 whole allspice berries
1-2 Tbsp sweetener of choice (brown sugar, coconut sugar, maple syrup)

Instructions:

Place all ingredients in a sauce pan over medium heat. Stir until sweetener of choice is incorporated. Reduce heat and continue to simmer for at least 30 minutes. Remove spices and serve hot.


